WILLIAM JAMES DUNLOP AWARD

The William James Dunlop Award was instituted by The Heritage Lodge No. 730 in 1985 to recognize the outstanding and continuing contribution by a Freemason to the Craft in Ontario. The Award is named in honour of M. W. Bro. William James Dunlop (1881-1961) who served as Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Canada in the Province of Ontario in 1937-1938. Dr. Dunlop was an eminent educator, and Member of the Ontario Legislature, where he served as Minister of Education (1951-1959).

The **recipient may or may not be a member** of The Heritage Lodge. Only **one award** is given **in any calendar year**. Nominations for this prestigious award should be sent to the Secretary of The Heritage Lodge, either by post or e-mail, **on or before November 15th** for consideration by the Awards Committee. The recipient will be announced and the award presented at the Annual Black-tie Dinner of the Lodge.
